



RaiseRight™

Thanks so much for considering joining our RaiseRight program! I'm the coordinator of the program, and I'll do my best to help you get started.

Just by ordering gift cards for any of the 575 brands available in the RaiseRight fundraising program, you can earn rebates that can be split between Greenhouse and a tuition credit for you (the default is a 50/50 split). You can even use the mobile app to buy ecards while you are at the store. For even more earnings, invite friends and relatives to use RaiseRight and have them select your family to be the recipient of the tuition credit.

There are two steps to get started:

1. Go to <https://www.raiseright.com/shop> or use the QR code, and use the Greenhouse enrollment code 3B8B7FF631399.
2. Complete and sign the attached waiver form. You can send it back in your parent packet. Until I receive the waiver from you, I will use the default of giving you 50% of any rebates you earn as tuition credit (Greenhouse keeps 50% for running the program).



You can use the RaiseRight website or app to order physical cards or ecards from any store that is part of the program. You can set up a credit card and/or a bank account to pay for the purchases you make. RaiseRight charges a 2.6% fee for credit card purchases and a \$0.29 fee for ACH payments. They list an option of giving a check to the coordinator, but we do not accept payments for RaiseRight. It would require a lot more manpower for us, and it would delay your receipt of the gift cards.

For most, if not all, gift cards, you have the option of purchasing a physical card or an ecard. We strongly encourage families to use ecards as much as possible. If you choose a physical card, we ask that you have it shipped directly to your home rather than to Greenhouse. First, they charge us a shipping fee for physical cards we order, so it reduces the amount of the rebate we receive (oftentimes, the fee is more than the rebate we receive). Second, I don't place orders for physical cards until the end of the month, so it delays when you receive your card. RaiseRight charges a shipping fee to families as well, so most people purchase the ecards.

I hope this helps you understand RaiseRight a little better. If not, feel free to ask me any questions you have, and I'll do my best to answer them.

RaiseRight Waiver Agreement

Greenhouse Christian Co-School (referred to herein as “we,” “us,” and “our”) sponsors the RaiseRight fundraising program, which allows you to purchase gift cards. Gift cards purchased through the program generate rebates from participating retailers. These rebates can be used as a credit to your tuition account, cash back to you, and/or a donation to us. The parties agree as follows:

Rebates earned will be used in the following ways:

50 % retained by Greenhouse for running the RaiseRight program (NOT deductible)

 % charitable contribution to Greenhouse (potentially deductible)

 % tuition credit for the following school family: _____

 % cash rebate to you (in the form of a check, NOT deductible)

TOTAL: 100%

Our RaiseRight program distributes the rebates monthly as a credit toward your tuition and fees, or quarterly (Mar, Jun, Sep, Dec) if you choose cash back.

With respect to your charitable contributions, we will provide you with all required acknowledgements under sections 170(f)(8) and 170(f)(17) of the Internal Revenue Code.

You agree to indemnify us against any loss incurred in connection with there being insufficient funds in your account to cover the checks or ACH transfers you issue to pay for your purchases. We make no representations or warranties of any kind with respect to the RaiseRight program. This agreement continues unless replaced by another and can be terminated by either us or you upon 60 days’ advance notice to the other.
